




Check products and accessories: lamp shade 130mm; crystal*16 ; needle*16; expansion screw (M6*50mm) (light source type: E26, not included)














Step 1: Remove the lamp cover plate and fix the lamp arm as shown.

Step 2: As shown in the picture wiring, connect the corresponding zero-fire wire and extension wire pairs, and insulate them with wire caps.

<p style="text-align: center;">Picture 4</p>  <p>Step 3: As shown in the figure install the cover plate.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Picture 5</p>  <p>Step 4: Put on the 70mm short rod, and turn the fan axis clockwise, so that the lamp body and the fan are fixed.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Picture 6</p>  <p>Step 5: As shown in the picture, with a 200mm or 100mm boom set the bell.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Picture 7</p>  <p>Step 6: Run the wire through the boom and thread the bolt.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Picture 8</p>  <p>Step 7: As shown in the picture, tighten 2 positioning screws (must be twisted, otherwise the fan light will be swayed)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Picture 9</p>  <p>Step 8: If it is a wooden ceiling, please use 4 self-tapping screws to fix the hanger; If the installation is on a concrete ceiling, secure the hanger with two explosive screws.</p>

<p>Step 9: Hang the fan light on the hanger and tighten the 4 screws on both sides (screws are pre-installed on the hanger)</p>	<p>Step 10: Plug the controller into the hanger, plug the wiring terminals according to the corresponding wire color, and then connect the zero and fire lines to the home power supply.</p>

<p>Step 11: Rotate the bell to seize and lock the screws.</p>	<p>Step 12: Install the light source and test the light, then install the crystal and lampshade if the light works.</p>
