## **Material Properties**

#### 1. Solid Wood

Trees will have a unique texture, scar, color and other natural marks during their growth. These elements constitute the natural beauty of wood. After being made into furniture, there will be slight discoloration when viewed under different light and different angles. That is because different grain minerals and light intensity affect vision, which is a normal phenomenon.

#### 2. Marble and Sintered Stone

The pattern of marble and sintered stone is unique to each piece. Due to the characteristics of the material, there is no guarantee that the pattern of each piece will be consistent with the pattern seen at the time of purchase.

## **Assembly Instructions**

 When assembling place all parts on a soft, clean, and flat surface such as a carpet to prevent scratches.



Do not discard any contents until after assembly is complete to avoid accidentally discarding small parts or hardware.

#### TOOLS YOU MAY NEED



#### Note: It is recommended that installation of the product be done by a qualified licensed furniture assembler.

#### A: Drawer/cabinet handles installation(they might be preinstalled behind the drawer panel):

#### D: Drawer panel adjustment(they might not level or couldn't be closed after a long way delivery):

F: Hinges adjustment(Please adjust the hinges when the cabinet doors are not level or couldn't be closed):



G: Level legs adjustment(adjust the level legs when the furniture is lightly not level or wobbly):



1.Place the installed item on the level floor. Check if all legs (with adjustable level legs) are touching the floor.

2. Adjust the level legs height of the untouched foot and its diagonally opposite foot the same time until all feet touch the floor

## **Use and Maintenance**

1. Keep the furniture vacant for half a month before use, and maintain good indoor ventilation to eliminate the residual odor in furniture surface coating.

2. Place the objects smoothly, Heavier objects should be placed at the bottom (layer)of the furniture to avoid the furniture from tipping over. Heavy objects should not be placed on the top of the wardrobe, so as not to cause the top plate to deform and sag and affect the opening of the cabinet door, high-temperature or frozen objects should be padded with high-termperature-resistant mats and placed on the furniture. Heavier or harder objects should be placed on the furniture table with a soft decorative tablecloth or a felt for protection.

3. Do not push hard objects directly on the furniture to avoid scratching the surface of the furniture.

4. Do not expose the furniture to sunlight for a long time or place the furniture close to the heating equipment, which can cause localized discoloration and fading.

5. Please avoid long-term exposure to humid environment to prevent mildew.

6. Place the furniture stably to avoid breaking the furniture feet or loosening the connection parts due to inclination.

7. Do not let items that are flammable and oxidizing touch the surface of the furniture, which may cause chemical reactions and damage to the furniture finishing.

8. Teach children not to play close to the glass sharp angles of furniture avoid accidental physical injury and damage to the furniture.

9. Open the doors and drawers of the furniture with appropriate force, and it is strictly forbidden to open and close them violently, which will cause loose connections.

10. Screws may become loose during long-term use. If necessary, retighten them to ensure stability and security.
